School Approach

Here is what I typically do and what works best for most districts. I usually perform student presentations first and then on the last day, then have the parent night. This allows for me to get direct feedback from the kids and then share the information with the parents. Please see included information on the parent workshop and what I cover there. The parent presentation is 1.25 hrs. And then time for questions. I stay as long as you need me to stay for follow up.

The youth presentations are 45 minutes with an additional 15 minutes for questions. All material can be tailored to the schools specific needs and as always is both age and culturally appropriate. The grade levels are usually broken up based on size and or maturity level and we can discuss that further based upon your feedback. Pricing depends on how many presentations you have and I offer multi booking discounts. We would need to discuss the breakout of how many presentations you will need which depends on the amount of students per grade level.
