- 3. Attendee agrees to hold FBC harmless, and to reimburse the same for any judgements, settlements, costs or other expenses (including legal fees) to which it may be subject, for any injury, damage, loss, or harm resulting or occurring to anyone (including, but not limited to, visitors) which may result directly or indirectly from or in connection with the activities and conduct of the Attendee and the Attendee's employees or representatives.
